

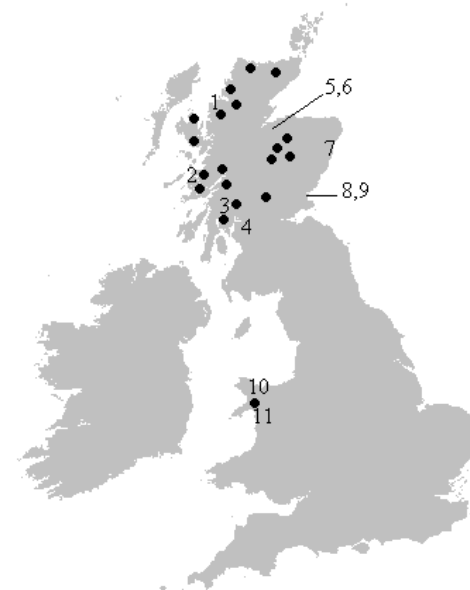
Arabis petraea (L.) Lam.

Perennial herb.

Habitat

Very open silt on acidic and basic rocks and rock ledges, on montane cliff faces and screes and on sea-cliffs; also on river shingle and on serpentine fellfield in Shetland. From near sea level (Shetland) to at least 1220 m (Aberdeen).
