

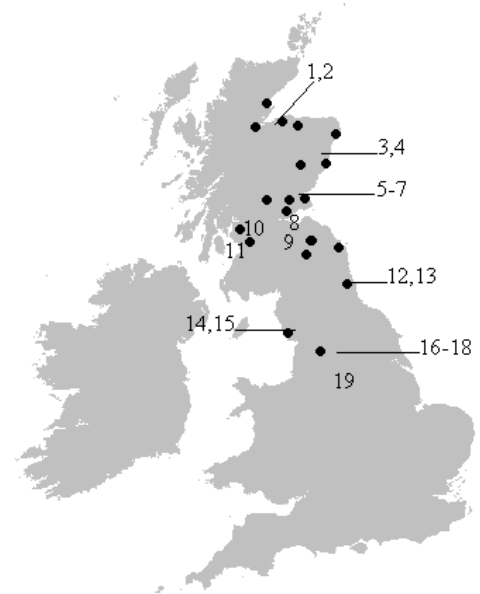
# *Corallorhiza trifida* Châtel.

Orchidaceae

### IUCN category (2001)

Vulnerable

### Habit

Saprophytic herb.

### Habitat

Shaded, damp, *Alnus* and *Salix* carr on raised mires and lake margins; also in dune-slacks with *Salix repens*; rarely in tall-herb fen, in *Betula* and *Pinus* woods (amongst *Sphagnum*) and on moorland. Secondary habitats include plantations and quarries. 0-365m.
