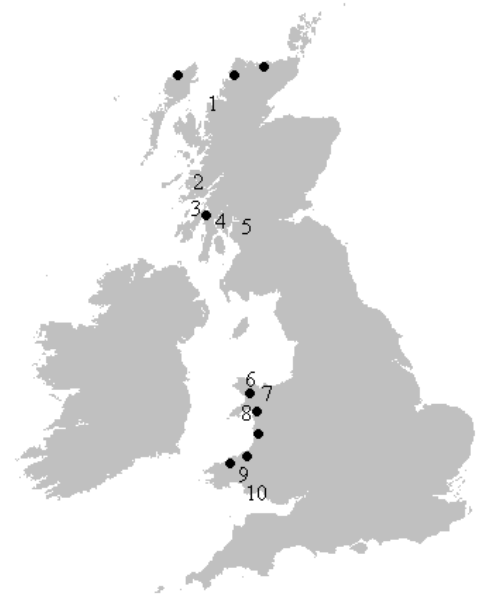
Hebridean Marsh Orchid
