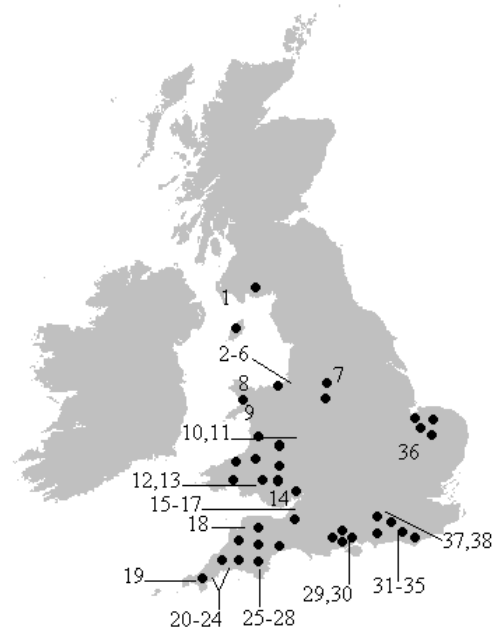


Euphrasia anglica Pugsley

Scrophulariaceae

IUCN category (2001)

Endangered. Endemic.

Habit

Annual herb.

Habitat

Old pastures, heaths, moorlands and disused quarries. Tightly grazed habitats. From lowland to 395 m (Ystrad-ffin, Carms.).

Substrates: damp acidic.
