Family

Scrophulariaceae

IUCN category (2001)

Endangered. Endemic.

Habit

Annual herb.

Habitat

Coastal rocks and eroding sea-cliff edges below maritime *Calluna vulgaris*-*Empetrum nigrum* heath. *Plantago* spp., particularly *P. maritima*, are constant associates and may act as hosts. Lowland.

Pressures or Reasons for decline

Limited losses through cultivation of cliff-tops.
