Arable fields on chalky soils.

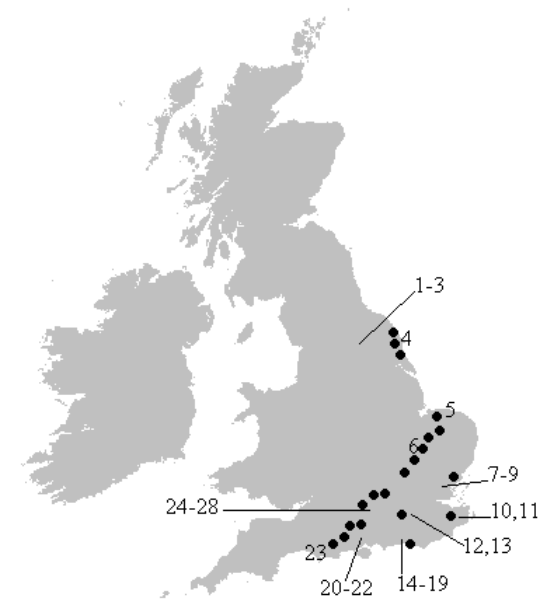
Associated uncommon species:

It usually grows in species-rich communities with other uncommon species including Dense-flowered and Few-flowered Fumitories, Prickly Poppy, Rough Poppy and Narrow-fruited Cornsalad.
