

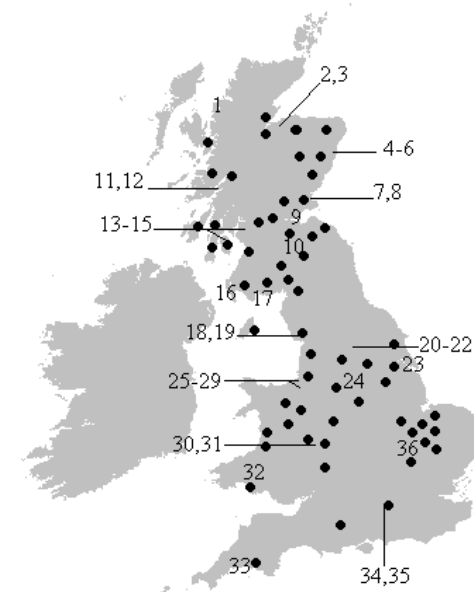
Galeopsis speciosa Mill.

- Propagation

Seed - sow spring in situ. Germination usually takes place within a month.

Grows in most soils, disliking heavy shade. This plant is sometimes grown in the wild garden.
