Liliaceae

IUCN category (2001)

Vulnerable

Habit

Bulbous herb (perennial).

Habitat

N. or N.-E.-facing, shaded and damp cliff-faces.

Reasons for decline

Reduced by collection since its discovery in the late 17th Century. Currently stable.
