### Habit

Perennial herb.

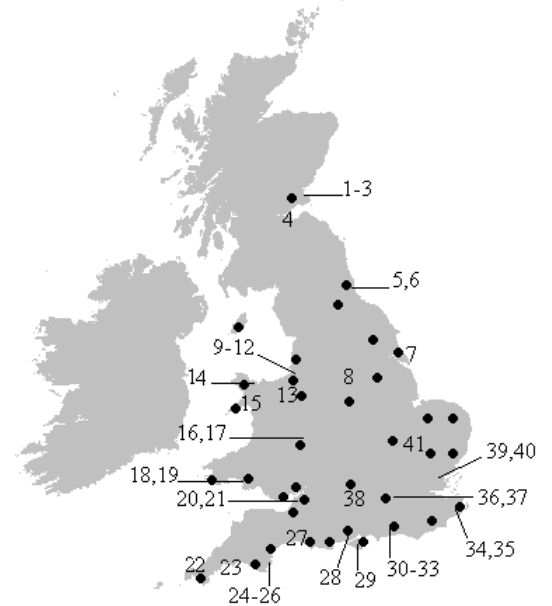
### Habitat

Damp or wet habitats, usually in areas of winter flooding; occurs in meadows and pastures in the flood plains of rivers, in marshes and fens, and in emergent and fringing vegetation by rivers, streams, canals, ditches, lakes and ponds. Lowland.

Drainage and re-seedling of old grassland or its conversion to arable
