

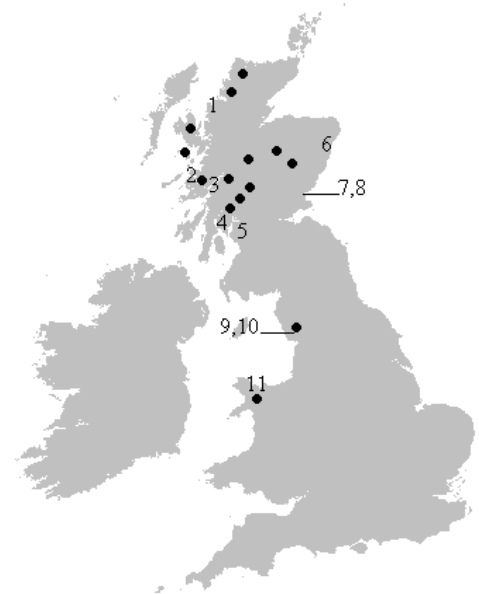
Poa glauca Vahl

Poaceae

IUCN category (2001)

Vulnerable

Habit

Tufted perennial herb.

Habitat

Damp mountain rock faces, open ledges, screes and rocky slopes on calcareous substrates, often with *Poa alpina*. From 305m on Trotternish, Skye (N Ebuades) to 1110m on Lochnagar (S Aberdeen).

Reasons for decline

Grazing.
