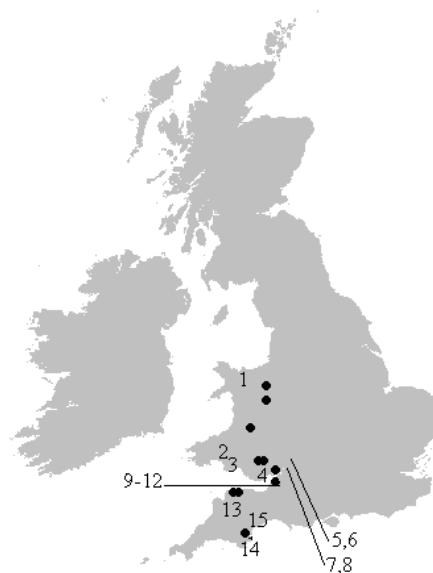


Sorbus anglica Hedlund
