

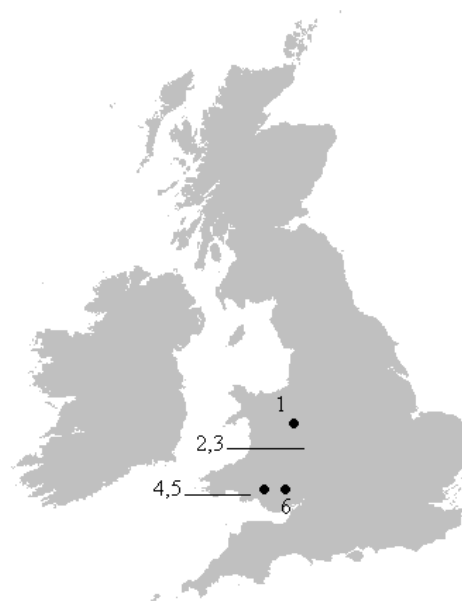
Sorbus leptophylla E.F. Warburg
