

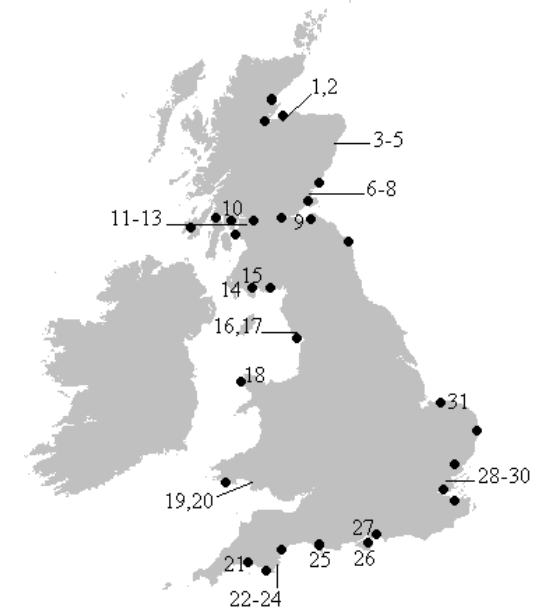
# *Zostera noltei* Hornem.

### Habitat

Sheltered estuaries and harbours.

Substrates: mixed sand and mud.
