

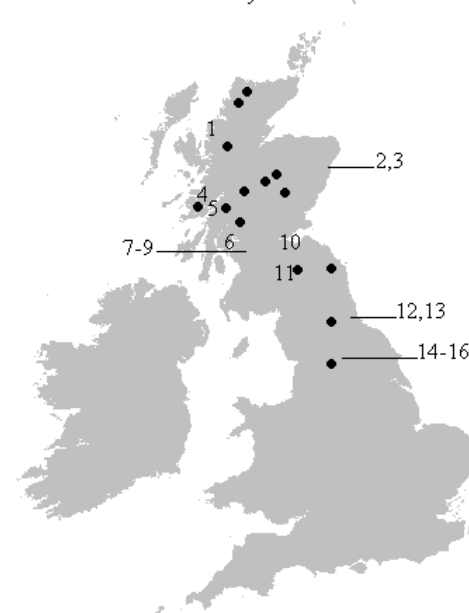
Alchemilla glomerulans Buser

Rosaceae

IUCN category (2001)

Vulnerable

Habit

Perennial herb (apomict).

Habitat

Ungrazed or lightly-grazed base-poor grassy habitats; a depauperate form grows in heavily-grazed flushes, and screens below cliffs; also on roadsides and in species-rich hay meadows.
