

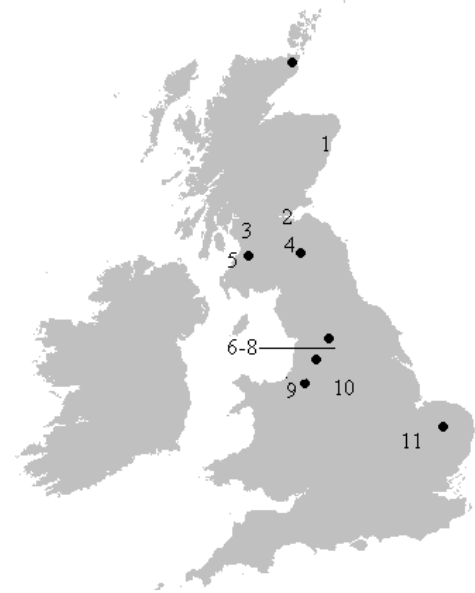
Calamagrostis stricta (Timm) Koeler
