

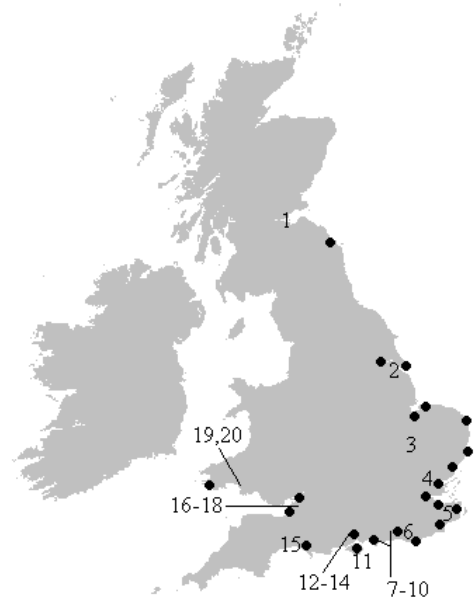
Carex divisa Huds.

Cyperaceae

IUCN category (2001)

Vulnerable

Habit

Rhizomatous perennial herb.

Habitat

Brackish ditches, dune-slacks and damp grasslands near the sea. It avoids areas of standing water. Lowland.

Reasons for decline

Coastal development, conversion of grazing marshes to arable.
