

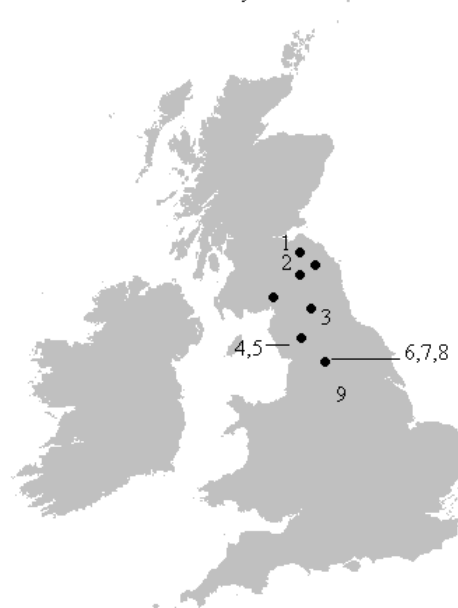
Crepis mollis (Jacq.) Asch.

Asteraceae

IUCN category (2001)

Endangered

Habit

Short-rhizomatous, winter-green perennial herb.

Habitat

Herb-rich grassland and wood-pasture. From 90 m to 670 m.

Substrates: shallow base-rich soils.
