

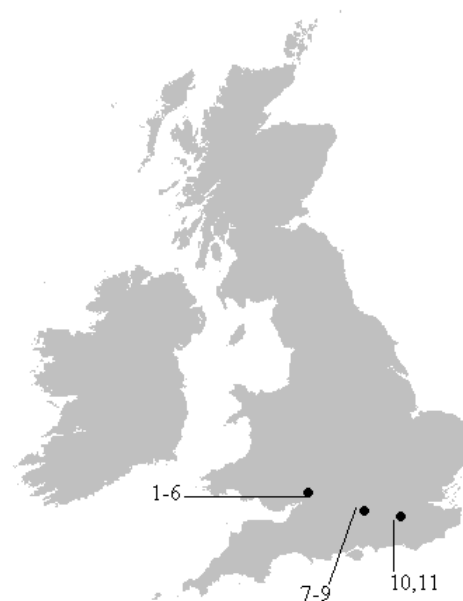
Cynoglossum germanicum Jacq.

Habit

Herb (biennial or short-lived perennial).

Habitat

Glades, deciduous woodland, hedge banks.

Unclear.
