

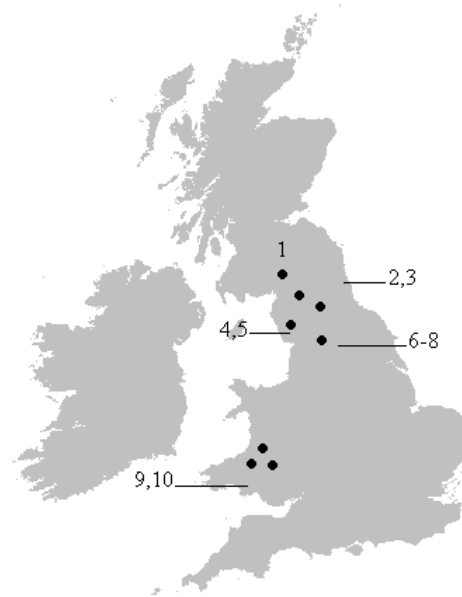
# *Euphrasia rostkoviana* ssp. *montana* (Jord.) Wettst.

### Family

Scrophulariaceae

### IUCN category (2001)

Vulnerable

### Habit

Annual herb.

### Habitat

Upland hay meadows, primarily of relatively dry sites but also in wet meadows and upland fens. Generally between 200-455m (Smallburn, N Northumberland), but also at 100m.

### Reasons for decline

Loss or agricultural improvement of hay meadows.
