Habitat

Grassland where the sward is kept short by grazing, mowing, exposure or disturbance, and on anthills. 0-375 m.

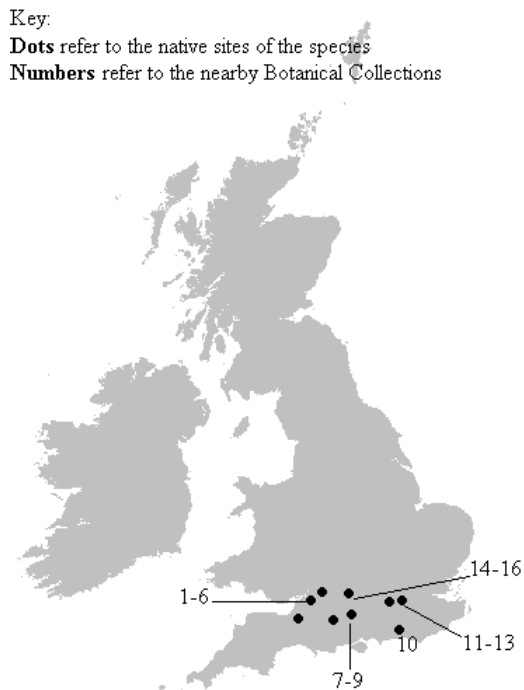
Substrates: species-rich chalk and limestone.

Reasons for decline

Loss of chalk grassland and reduced grazing.
