
# Lithospermum arvense L.

Field Gromwell

Habit

Annual herb of arable fields.

#### Life cycle

Flowers from mid-May to July. Seed is quite long-lived. Germination occurs both between October and December and in March and April.

#### Habitat

Waste ground, disturbed habitats. Substrates: light, dry, calcareous soils.

## Associated uncommon species:

On chalk and limestone soils in the south of England it

frequently occurs in species-rich communities with Rough Poppy, Prickly Poppy, Narrow-fruited Cornsalad, Shepherd's-needle and Dense-flowered Fumitory.

#### Reasons for decline

Agricultural intensification.


