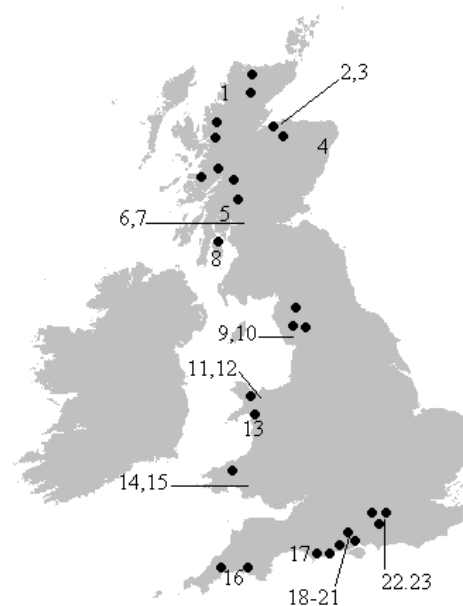


Lycopodiella inundata (L.) Holub

Family

Lycopodiaceae

IUCN category (2001)

Endangered.

Habit

Prostrate perennial herb.

Habitat

Margins of lakes, pools, flushes and trackways.

Substrates: wet, bare, peaty or sandy.

Reasons for decline

Drainage, lack of grazing and other disturbance, and conversion to scrub, especially in England.
