Life cycle

Flowers from late June to October. Seed is long-lived. Germination is mainly from March to May, although there is some during the summer and autumn.

Habitat

Arable and other cultivated ground including among horticultural crops, and in gardens and waste places.

Associated uncommon species:

Weasel's-snout usually grows with Corn Marigold, and sometimes with Small-flowered Catchfly and Lesser Quakinggrass

Reasons for decline

Susceptible to many broad-spectrum herbicides, growing poorly in fully fertilised modern crops. Also affected by the declining area of spring-sown crops, especially in eastern England, and the conversion of arable land to pasture in the West.


