Family

Boraginaceae

IUCN category (2001)

Endangered

Habit

Herb (perennial).

Habitat

Ancient woods, where *Acer campestre*, *Corylus* and *Fraxinus* are the usual dominant trees, in areas with poorly drained, fertile soil.

Reasons for decline

Cessation of coppicing and habitat destruction.
