### **Family**

Rosaceae

### **IUCN category (2001)**

Vulnerable. Endemic.

### **Habit**

Small to medium-sized tree.

### **Habitat**

Open, rocky *Quercus petraea* woodland, occasionally in open cliff scrub close to the shore.
